

Tulos: Candle Lighting and Prayer Offering

"For you are my lamp, O Lord; And the Lord illumines my darkness." 2 Samuel 22:29

Lighting of candles is one of the devotional practices of devotees of Our Lady of the Rosary of Manaoag. Pilgrims, in particular, see to it that they light a candle and offer a prayer before returning to their respective homes. To a Christian and a devotee of Apo Baket, the lighting of candles is practiced "not just to dispel night's gloom but also to represent Christ, the Uncreated and Eternal Light" (2nd Century Academic Scholar).
